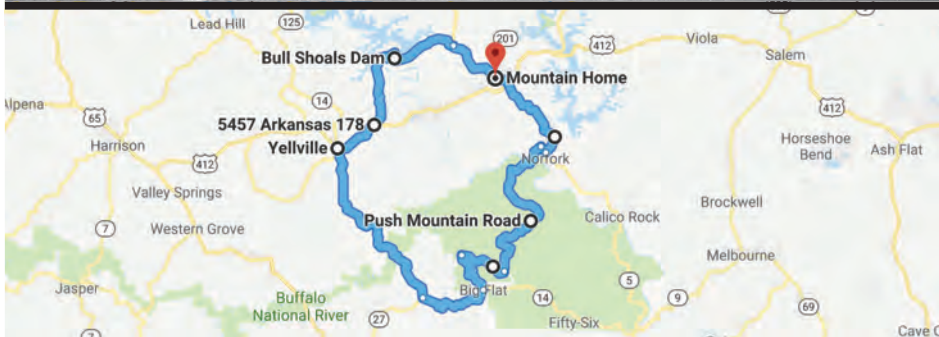

Taking AR-5 south out of Mountain Home headed towards Mountain View, take a right onto AR-201 north then left on AR-341 south for a roller-coaster ride that attracts sport bike enthusiasts from across the nation—Push Mountain Road. After going over the top and through some awesome tarmac, take a right on AR-14 and make your way northwest for an excellent ride of broad sweepers to Yellville. Turn right on AR-62/AR-412 East before jumping on AR-178 North to Bull Shoals Dam. Wiggle around the lake before getting back on AR-5, ending in Mountain Home.
